At the November 1st board meeting, just prior to the election of the 3 new trustees, the old board pushed through the **\$228 a year* fee increase**, in closed session, without it being on the agenda, and with no chance of input from attending homeowners!

The 2005 budget will be revisited at the Monday, Jan. 10th meeting of the Board of Trustees, and hopefully the fee increase will be reduced or eliminated entirely.
